

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Finding hOMe Retreat | Bali 2027

We understand that life happens. This policy is designed to be fair to you while also protecting the commitments we have made to our venue and partners on your behalf. Please read this carefully before registering.

Guest-Initiated Cancellations

Cancellation Window	Refund	Notes
On or before December 31, 2026	100% minus \$250 admin fee	The \$250 fee covers credit card processing and administrative costs.
January 1 - January 31, 2027	50% of total paid	50% of all payments made to date will be returned.
February 1, 2027 or later	No refund	All payments are non-refundable. We strongly recommend travel insurance to protect your investment.

Important Notes on Cancellations

- The \$500 deposit is non-refundable in all circumstances.
- All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to brooke@bukayoga.com.
- Refunds will be processed within 14 business days of written confirmation.
- Travel insurance that includes trip cancellation coverage is required. This protects you fully in the event of illness, injury, or unforeseen circumstances.
- If a guest finds a replacement participant acceptable to the host, a transfer may be considered at no additional administrative fee prior to February 1, 2027.

Host-Initiated Cancellation

Life is Lived in the Pause reserves the right to cancel the retreat under extraordinary circumstances, including but not limited to natural disaster, government travel advisories, force majeure events, or insufficient enrollment.

In the event of a host-initiated cancellation:

- All payments made will be refunded in full within 30 days.
- We will make every effort to notify guests as early as possible.

- Life is Lived in the Pause is not responsible for non-refundable flights, hotel bookings, or other travel expenses. This is why travel insurance is required.

Travel Insurance Requirement

Travel insurance is required for all retreat participants. Proof of an active policy must be provided prior to your final payment (due April 1, 2027).

Your policy must cover at minimum:

- Trip cancellation and interruption
- Emergency medical expenses (\$50,000 minimum recommended)
- Emergency medical evacuation

We recommend World Nomads (worldnomads.com), which is the provider we use personally. Their Standard Plan covers adventure activities including yoga and hiking, and is available to US residents traveling internationally. A week-long policy for one traveler typically runs \$200-\$350 depending on age and coverage level.
